NOTIFICATION

No. SO (Arms) HD/2-8/2004(Vol-10): In exercise of powers conferred under section (11) of the Pakistan Arms Ordinance 1965, the Competent Authority has been pleased to approve the following Arms Policy for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, FATA and PATA.

- A. Note: This policy will supersede all other policies issued before.
 B. Short Title: This policy may be called Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Arms Policy, 2012.
 C. Enforcement: This policy shall come into force from the date of its notification.
 D. Interpretation: In this policy, unless or until there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:
- NPB Licence means: Non-prohibited bore arms licence.
 - Provincial Govt. means: Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - Competent Authority means: Secretary to the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Home & Tribal Affairs Department.
 - District Authority means: District Coordination Officer or any other officer exercising his powers.
 - Political Authority means: Political Agent or any other officer exercising his powers.
 - Gratis arms licence means: A licence issued to a public servant, member of armed forces, public representatives or any other person of special status, free of charges, partially or in all.
 - Category means: Specified group of arms manufacturers/dealers with different standard and different terms, conditions & privileges.
 - Positive List means: A list indicating weapons of non-prohibited bore.
 - Gazetted Officer: An officer of BPS-17 or above notified so by the government in official gazette.
 - Public Representative: Sitting member of National Assembly of Pakistan, Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa or Member Senate of Pakistan.

1. Individual Arms Licences: Licences of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for NPB weapons may be issued to all individuals having Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC), subject to the verification by the police, for a period of one year ending on 31st December by the District Coordination Officer/Political Agent concerned, in exercise of the powers delegated to them by Home Department.

A list, indicating details of individual licences issued in each district/agency, shall be furnished to Home Department on fortnightly basis, duly countersigned by the District Coordination Officers/Political Agents concerned, to ensure that the sanctioned quota is strictly adhered to. In case of failure, powers of issuance of licences will be withdrawn from the D.C.O/P.A. Convicts, excluding for convictions for minor offences or traffic violations, would not be eligible for an arms licence.

Application for fresh arms licence shall be submitted along with stamp paper, worth Rs. 450, fixed under article 8(A) of Schedule-I of Finance Act 2007, to the issuing authority.

Following is the positive list of weapons:-

- i) Shotgun
- ii) Revolver or Pistol other than Prohibited Bore
- iii) Rifle other than Prohibited Bore
- iv) Sword.
- v) Any weapon notified so in official gazette by the competent authority.

2. **Individual Arms Licences to the persons belonging to other than Khyber Pakhtunkhwa/FATA:** Applications for the issuance of individual arms licences of the persons do not belonging to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa/FATA but residing herein may be considered for issuance of NPB licence subject to the recommendation of a gazetted officer or public representative, subject to the fulfillment of all formalities. However persons applying for gratis/free arms licences shall apply to the district/agency of their domicile only.

3. **Monthly Quota of Districts / Agencies:** District / Agency-wise monthly quota of arms licenses is as under:

S. No.	Region	Quota per month
1.	Provincial H/Q (Peshawar)	800
2.	Divisional Headquarters i.e. Swat, Abbottabad, Bannu, Kohat, Mardan and D.I.Khan	300 per District
3.	All other Districts in the Province and Agencies in FATA	200 per District / Agency

The Provincial Government employees who are entitled for one free NPB Arms Licence may be over and above the fixed quota.

4. **All Pakistan Licences:** Validity of NPB licences may be extended to other provinces by the Home department on recommendation of:

- a. Concerned District Coordination Officer/Political Agent.
- b. Commanding Officer, in case of army men.
- c. A gazetted officer or public representative.

Licences shall be routed through the D.C.O/P.A, who has issued it. Each District/agency shall nominate a focal person to coordinate affairs of arms licences with Home Department.

Arms licences of NPB of other provinces will also be considered for extension of validity to whole of Pakistan subject to verification/recommendation by a gazetted officer or a public representative.

5. **Rounds/Cartridges:** A maximum of 200 cartridges/rounds shall be allowed on an arms licence of NPB. However fee, @ Rs. 20/round, will be charged from private applicants for increase in rounds/cartridges excluding 25 already granted at the time of issuance of licence. A maximum of 100 rounds, free of charges, will be admissible to gratis arms licences.

Home department, on recommendation of D.C.Os/P.As, will increase the number of rounds/cartridges in licences.

6. **Retainers:** Only spouse and children of a licensee would be eligible for being entered in the licence as retainers.

7. **Duplicate Arms Licence:** A duplicate or a triplicate of Non-Prohibited Bore arms licence may be issued on production of the following documents.

- a. Affidavit on stamp paper.
- b. Copy of renewal certificate, indicating the period of deposited fee.
- c. Daily dairy report registered in concerned police station.
- d. Copy of CNIC.

8. Transfer of Individuals' Arms Licence: Transfer of individuals' licence will be permissible on inheritance basis to a legal heir of the deceased licence holder provided that the successor also fulfills all the legal requirements and subject to the production of consent of all other legal heirs. Statements of all legal heirs, for the purpose, shall be made on stamp paper, duly signed/thumb impressed by the concerned and verified by District Officer Revenue or District Authority in case of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and or Political Authority in case of FATA. However special provisions of the deceased licensee i.e. all Pakistan validation or extra number of rounds/cartridges etc. shall not be transferred by default. For availing any such provision, the beneficiary may go through the laid down procedure once again.

9. Arms Licences to Private Security Companies: NPB arms licences may be issued in the name of a Private Security Company, registered in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Such company shall provide registration documents and details of guards, deployed in the province. However, clearance from the Preventive Regulations (PR) Section of the Home Department, which regulates affairs of private security companies, shall be obtained prior to processing any application for licences, every time. Each company, having valid registration for operating in the province, shall be entitled for licences equivalent to the 2/3rd of the total number of security guards of the company deployed in the province i.e. a private security company can hire a maximum of 400 guards in the province, hence can obtain a maximum of 300 licences only. Extension of validation of licences, in the name of company, to whole of Pakistan shall be admissible to 1/3rd of the issued licences (to a maximum of 100 licences only), subject to the approval of competent authority. However these licences can be used only by the security guards of the company deployed in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa/FATA but moving in other provinces in line with their duties.

Licences issued in the name of private security companies will be over and above of the monthly quota allotted to districts.

10. Issuance of Gratis Arms Licences to Serving /Retired Army Personnel: Authorization of licences against fee and gratis arms licences for NPB private weapons for all ranks of Pakistan Army is regulated under 'Army Regulations (Instructions)', 2000 (clauses 475 to 494). Relevant provisions are as under:-

- a. **Serving Army Personnel:** As per Army Rules (instruction 490) serving officers, junior commissioned officer and soldiers must apply through their respective station/unit commander. They are authorized to apply for arms licence for NPB private arms as under:
 - i. **Officers:** May apply for fee paying licence for revolver or pistol.
 - ii. **Junior Commissioned Officers:** Are authorized to hold 1x pistol / 1x revolver / 7 mm on gratis arms licence.
 - iii. **Soldiers:** Are authorized to hold 1x pistol / 1x revolver / Shot Gun on gratis arm licence.
- b. **Retired Army personnel:** As per Army Rules (1) 475 and 493 f & g.
 - i. Retired officers are authorized gratis arms licence for NPB Arms (1x pistol and 1x revolver or 2 x pistols or 2 x revolvers).

- ii. Retired Junior Commissioned Officers are authorized gratis arms licence for NPB Arms (1x pistol or 1x revolver / 7 mm).

11. **Gift to General Officers on Retirement:** As per Army Rules (1) 493 a, all retiring general officers will be issued with gratis arms licence for the gifted weapon.

12. **Issuance of Gratis Arms Licence to Awardee Officers / Junior Commissioned Officers, Soldiers:** In accordance with the latest policy all recipients of military awards are authorized to possess gratis arms licences of following weapons:-

Extension of validity of all or any of gratis arms licence, issued under Army Rules, to all Pakistan, shall be subject to the approval of the competent authority.

13. **Gratis Licences to employees of Provincial Government:** All employees of provincial government will be entitled for one gratis arms licence subject to the approval of competent authority. However employees of autonomous bodies, authorities or corporations do not cover under this provision.

14. **Gratis Licences to Employees of Federal Government:** Employees of federal government having BPS-17 or above will be entitled for one free licence in accordance with the provision given by the federal government subject to the approval of competent authority. However employees of autonomous bodies, authorities and corporations do not cover under this provision.

15. **Gratis Licences to Member of Provincial Assembly:** In accordance with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Provincial Assembly Privileges Act 1973 and subsequent notification of Home department {No. SO (Arms) HD/238-75 dated Peshawar 14-04-1986}, an MPA is entitle for 4 gratis arms licences, valid for the tenure of his assembly membership and six months immediately after ceasing of his assembly membership. Validation of such licences can also be extended to all Pakistan subject to the approval of competent authority.

16. **Sell of Arms & Ammunition to Individuals:** No weapon or ammunition shall be sold to anyone who does not possess a valid licence for the purpose. Details of buyers, including, Name, CNIC, mobile number, date of purchase, licence number, make of weapon and quantity may be maintained by the dealer.

17. **Grant of Arms Manufacturing & Dealership Licences:** Licences in Forms IX & XI (arms manufacturing), X & XII (arms dealership) and XIII (arms repair & keeping) will be issued by the Home Department in three categories, after completion of following conditions.

a. Conditions applicable prior to issuance of licence:

- Application on stamp paper worth Rs.1500 for Forms IX & XI, Forms X & XII and Form XIII separately, fixed under article 8(A) of Schedule-I of Finance Act 2007.
- Bank statement for the past six months, showing minimum deposit of Rs. 1.0 million.
- Verification of antecedents and clearance by Special Branch Police in cases of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and from Intelligence Bureau in cases of FATA.
- National Taxation Number (NTN).
- Surety bond or undertaking on stamp paper wherein compliance of arms policy shall be guaranteed by the applicant.

b. Conditions applicable after the issuance of licence:

- Property ownership certificate, lease agreement or tenancy contract, whichever status the property possesses, being utilized for factory/shop and site map, will be furnished by the licensee.
- Details of machinery and equipments installed by the arms manufacturers and equipments installed by the dealers.
- Names of all technical & non-technical persons, along with their valid CNIC, employed in an arms manufacturing unit or arms dealership shop shall also be furnished.

Time period of 12 months, shall be granted for establishment of manufacturing unit or dealership shop, after the issuance of licence. In case of failure, licence shall stand cancelled. Another 6 months grace period shall be granted if the licensee deposits licence renewal fee.

Licence in Form-X will be issued by the District Coordination Officer/Political Agent concerned, after approval of the Home Department.

20. **Renewal of Licences in Forms IX, X, XI, XII & XIII:** These licences shall be renewed, only for one year ending on December 31, subject to the clearance of Home department/district authority concerned and deposit of renewal fee.

21. **Disposal of Wastage:** Manufacturer shall ensure safe and synchronized disposal of wastage of manufacturing units, keep its environmental impact in view. A copy of such arrangements, in writing, shall be furnished to Home department and as with D.C.O or Political Agent, as the case may be.

22. **Outsourcing of manufacturing facilities:** Manufacturers or arms & ammunition can utilize facilities of installed machinery of manufacturing units other than their own, within the industrial estate, for improved quality of their products. However for utilization of such facilities available outside the industrial estate, No Objection Certificate (NOC) shall be obtained by the manufacturer from the Home Department. Home department may issue NOCs for the purpose on written request of manufacturer, wherein all details of parts/components being treated shall be stated, subject to the approval of competent authority.

23. **Transportation Licences (TLs):** Home department shall grant licences for transportation of arms and ammunition to arms manufacturers within their respective quota limits. TL will also be granted to the dealers possessing import licence.

Transportation Licence will be issued on recommendation of District Coordination Officer concerned. N.O.C from C.C.P.O/District Police Officer of the station from which consignment is booked as well as from D.C.O of the district and Home department of the province, where arms/ammunition tend to be delivered, shall also be furnished while applying for a TL.

Complete description of the weapon and ammunition i.e. name, bore, made, type etc. shall be mentioned by the applicant in the application while applying for a T.L. Issued T.L shall be valid for 60 days only, compliance report of which shall be submitted within 7 days of expiry.

Video footage of packing, sealing and handing arms/ammunition over to transporting authority (railways etc.) shall also be submitted to Home department along with compliance report of TL by the manufacturer/dealer through the D.C.O concerned. Video footage must be of following standard.

- i. May not be less than 15 min duration.
- ii. May be continuous from sealing packing till the handing over to transporting authority.
- iii. Accompanying police officer may be seen in the footage.
- iv. Issued T.L may also be shown in the footage so that reference and date of the TL can be observed.
- v. Quality of the video footage must be standard.

The police party, accompanying the consignment, shall furnish certificate of successful delivery of the consignment to the concerned, to the Home department within 7 days positively.

24. **NOC for Import of Arms & Ammunition:** NOC for import of arms and ammunition to the province will be issued by the Home Department to a dealer having valid licence, within the respective quota limits.

25. **Transfer of Licences in Forms IX, X, XI, XII & XIII:** Cases of transfer of these licences can be considered only on 'inheritance' or 'extreme hardship/need' basis and upon the satisfaction of competent authority, provided that the successor also fulfills all the legal requirements of such licence. Statements of all concerned on stamp paper, duly attested by the Registrar/Sub-Registrar or District/Political Authority, shall be furnished along with such application. The Registrar/Sub-Registrar or District/Political Authority will also authenticate the agreement between the parties before the transfer is affected.

26. **Change of Title:** change of title of the company will be admissible to any arms dealer or manufacturer on application made on plain paper subject to the approval of competent authority. However fee @ Rs. 2000/- will be charged for the change of title. Title can be the name of the licensee only or a general name i.e. Shaheen, Pearl, etc. which shall not be the name of a person or in use of any other company.

27. **Addition/Inclusion of Sale Agent in Licences in Forms X and XII:** Sale Agents will be added to licences in Forms X & XII subject to proper verification of the individuals by police and recommendation of District Coordination Officer/Political Agent concerned.

28. **Addition/Inclusion of Proprietorship in Forms-IX, X, XI and XII:** Proprietorship will be added to licences in Forms IX, X, XI and XII subject to proper verification of the individuals by the Special Branch Police in cases of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Intelligence Bureau in cases of FATA and recommendation of District Coordination Officer/Political Agent concerned. However fee, equivalent to the licence transfer fee will be applicable.

29. **End User Certificate (Annex-E):** District Authority is authorized to sign End User Certificates. Competent authority will countersign the same before submitting it to quarters concerned.

30. **Registration of Licences at Nearest Police Station:** Arms licences issued in any Form (individual, manufacturing and dealership) shall be registered at nearest police station within 60 days of issuance of licence.

32. **Safety Measures:** Safety equipments, including fire extinguishers, emergency medical service, masks etc. may be installed at each unit and proper functionality ensured.

33. **Inspection of Arms Manufacturing/Dealership Units by D.C.Os/P.A:** Regular/periodical inspection of each arms manufacturing and dealership unit shall be carried out by the D.C.O/P.A in their respective jurisdictions. Inspection report shall be furnished to Home department.

34. **Inspection of Arms Manufacturing/Dealership Units by Police:** Inspection of an arms and ammunition manufacturing or dealership unit by the police may be carried out only two times in a year under normal circumstances. Only the officer, not below the rank of an ASP/DSP, is authorized to carry out such inspection. Inspection reports may also be furnished to Home department.

35. **Inspection/Monitoring Team:** A vigilant monitoring team comprising of

- Representative of Police Department not below the rank of an A.S.P
- Representative of concerned Commissioner Office not below the grade-17
- Representative of concerned District/Political Authority not below grade-17, headed by representative of Home department, not below the rank of a Deputy Secretary, shall monitor and ensure the compliance of arms policy by all stakeholders in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and FATA. Inspection shall be randomly done by this team, at least once in a year of each manufacturing/dealership unit and certificate issued, if satisfied. Inspection certificate shall be displayed by the manufacturing unit/shop till the next inspection is done. If anyone found

guilty of violating the policy, action against the violator shall be recommended by the team to the competent authority.

Note:

- a. Violation of any or all of these rules shall result in cancelation of licence and strict legal action under relevant rules.
- b. The competent authority shall be at liberty to alter/amend any clause/instruction containing in the policy.
- c. The interpretation of the competent authority, in respect of policy above shall be final.
